Esther M. (Srock) Bryan, age 98, of Sunrise Beach, passed away Tuesday, July 5, 2011, at the Laurie Care Center. She was born April 1, 1913, in Tebbie, Mississippi, the daughter of the late Arthur J. and Louise M. Misenholder Srock.
