



## Fay Lucille Silvey

Fay Lucille (James) Silvey, age 91, of Versailles, passed away Tuesday, September 27, 2016, at SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital in Jefferson City. She was born September 30, 1924, near Barnett, Missouri, to Charles and Dora (Hayes) James.
