



## Frank Edward Stimac

March 17, 1933 - August 28, 2011

Frank Edward Stimac, Sr., age 78, of Gravois Mills, passed away Sunday, August 28, 2011. He was born March 17, 1933, in Kansas City, Kansas, the son of the late John and Nellie Parkins Stimac.

On October 27, 1956, in Hutchison, Kansas, he was united in marriage to Martha A. Ramsey, who survives of the home.

He graduated from Wyandotte High School in Kansas City, Kansas in 1951, and attended Cerritos College in Cerritos, California.
