Frank Donald Terry, age 89, of Laurie, passed away Wednesday, January 8, 2020, at his home. He was born May 23, 1930, in Gladstone, Missouri, a son of the late Frank Day and Ethel Mae (Brown) Terry.

On December 19, 1950, in Kansas City, Kansas, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Mary Ann (Moore) Terry. Together they shared sixty-nine years of marriage.

Donald was born and raised on a farm in Laurie and farmed most of his life. He served in the United States Army as a combat field medic during the Korean Conflict and was honorably discharged on April 16, 1960. Donald joined the Union Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners Local 1851-7286 in Sedalia where he was a proud member for over fifty years.

Donald was an avid outdoorsman and raccoon hunter. He played the guitar and he and Mary Ann enjoyed their weekly gospel sings at local churches and nursing homes for many years. Donald was a baseball fan always rooting for his favorite team, the St. Louis Cardinals.

He was a member of the George M. Waddell VFW Post 5178 in Gravois Mills.

Donald will be remembered as a loving husband, father, grandfather and

great-grandfather.

In addition to his wife, Mary Ann, he is survived by his children, Donna Johnson and husband Jerry of Versailles, Missouri, Karen Owen and husband Fred of Camdenton, Missouri and David Terry and wife Kelly of Laurie, Missouri; five grandchildren, Denny Terry, Emily Terry, Megan Lasson, Dylan Johnson and Lyndsay Porter; eight great-grandchildren; his brothers, G.L. Terry of Branson, Missouri, Day Terry of Tightwad, Missouri and Larry Terry of Tightwad, Missouri; his sister, Shirley Fockler of Wichita, Kansas and many other relatives and friends. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his siblings, Harold, Norman, Juanita, Almeta, Louise and June.
