Gary worked as a Marine mechanic for over 39 years. In his spare time, he enjoyed playing golf, gardening and barbecuing for his family and friends.

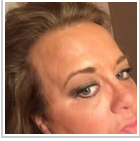
He loved his family and his dogs and especially treasured the time he spent with his grandchildren. He will be missed by all who knew and loved him.

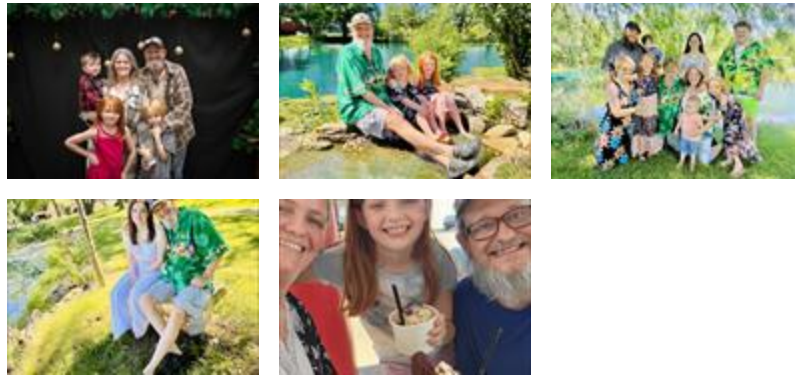
