Harold Gene Fry of Sunrise Beach, Missouri, was born May 14, 1945 in Dexter, Missouri. He died Friday, April 20, 2018 at his home at Lake of the Ozarks.

He retired from Boeing Military Aircraft where he worked for over forty-eight years as a manufacturing engineer. Harold was a military veteran where he served his country in the Army in Vietnam for two years (1966-1967) and was honorably discharged.
