Harold “Hal” Trokey, Sr., age 80, of Camdenton, Missouri, departed this life on Friday, October 24, 2014 in Columbia, Missouri.

He was born on December 9, 1933 in Washington County, Missouri the son of Oscar Trokey and Marie (Guenther) Trokey.

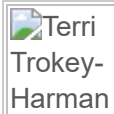
