Helen L. Bolton, age 88, of Versailles, passed away Sunday evening, October 15, 2006 at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. She was born July 10, 1918 in Versailles, the daughter of the late Warner and Lena Marriott Hulett.

On December 26, 1941 she was united in marriage to Roy Eugene Bolton who preceded her in death on October 27, 1995.

She graduated from St. Luke's School of Nursing in Kansas City as a Registered Nurse. 1960 thru 1983 Mrs. Bolton served as the first Public Health Nurse and Administrator for the Morgan County Health Center. She also worked at the Gunn Clinic for many years.

Mrs. Bolton was a lifetime member of the First Baptist Church of Versailles where she served as the church pianist and Sunday school teacher.
