Helen “JoAnn” Moulton, age 79, of Linn Creek, passed away Wednesday, May 26, 2021, at her home surrounded by family. She was born August 27, 1941, in Kansas City, Missouri, daughter of Buford and Fanny Imogene (Peeler) Short. Following Imogene’s passing, Buford married Ruby Jean Diehm, who lovingly raised JoAnn as her daughter.

JoAnn was a cheerleader and prom queen at Pleasant Hill High School and graduated in 1959.
