February 8, 1918 - May 28, 2016

Hollis Lee Sinclair, age 98, of Barnett, passed away Saturday, May 28, 2016, at his home. He was born February 8, 1918, in Russell Springs, Kentucky, a son of the late Clarence A. and Martha (Canada) Sinclair.
