Irvin P. Kuehn, age 89, of Gravois Mills, passed away Saturday, March 15, 2014, at his home. He was born January 30, 1925, in Fordyce, Nebraska, a son of the late Gerhard and Rose (Weiblehause) Kuehn.

He was a United States Navy veteran serving in World War II on the USS Enterprise from 1942 to 1946 when he was honorably discharged.
