Jack D. Shepherd, age 88, of Gravois Mills, passed away Thursday, December 10, 2009, at the Lake Regional Health System. He was born February 24, 1921, in Kansas City, Missouri, the son of the late Homer and Nellie Gresham Shepherd.

On December 24, 1940, he was united in marriage to Doris “Dodie” Webb, who preceded him in death on February 28, 2004. On June 24, 2006, in Versailles, he was united in marriage to Katherine Miller, who survives of the home.

Jack owned and operated Shepherd Industries until his retirement in 1980. He was a United States Army veteran having served in WWII.
