Jack T. Lemmons, age 90, of Versailles, passed away Saturday, December 29, 2012, at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. He was born June 18, 1922, in Sweet Springs, Missouri, a son of the late Jack S. and Melville Fenwick Lemmons.

He was a World War II veteran serving his country in the United States Army from 1943 to 1945. He was a recipient of the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star.

Jack retired as a supervisor for Allied Signal after 25 years of service.

He attended the Versailles United Methodist Church. He was also a past member of the Osage Community Elks Lodge 2705 in Laurie and the Rolling Hills Country Club in Versailles.

Jack enjoyed trap shooting, bowling, fishing, playing golf and riding motorcycles.

In addition to his wife, Katie, of 32 years, he is survived by his brother, Beryl Lemmons of Arnold, Missouri; daughters, Pat Kinzie of St. Peters, Missouri, Mickey Starr and husband Kenny of Odessa, Missouri and Cindey Ammerman and husband Steve of Lee's Summit, Missouri; six grandchildren; fifteen great-

grandchildren; and many other relatives and friends. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers, Howard Lemmons and Ray Lemmons.
