



Jacob Parrish Ramey

Jacob Parrish Ramey, age 79, of Syracuse, passed away Sunday, November 4, 2012, at the Harry S. Truman Memorial Veterans' Hospital in Columbia. He was born May 20, 1933, in Greeley, Colorado, a son of the late Herbert Ralph and Eva Mae Klein Ramey. On August 18, 1961, at Mt.
