James E. Dump, age 100, of Versailles, passed away Wednesday, November 14, 2018, at Lake Regional Health System in Osage Beach. He was born September 10, 1918, a son of the late Roy and Ethel (Bluhm) Dump.

James attended rural schools in Pettis County. He was drafted by the United States Army during WWII where he served in the signal corps for several years. Following his honorable discharge, he returned home to help his parents.

They moved to Denver, Colorado, where he assisted in the operation of a parking garage. Later, he obtained work at Rocky Flats Atomic Energy Plant. Following his retirement, they traveled to various places in the United States during the summer months and lived in their RV in Mission, Texas during the winter. There, he helped many friends for over twenty years before making Versailles their permanent residence.

He enjoyed his 100th birthday party, visiting with many friends and reminiscing of happy memories. James always had a smile and knew how to say thank

you. He will be missed by all who knew and loved him.
