James Lawrence Minogue, age 81, of Sunrise Beach, Missouri, passed away Thursday, March 22, 2018 in Lake Regional Hospital, Osage Beach, Missouri. He was born August 16, 1936 in Chicago, Illinois, a son of James Martin and Theresa (Stalzer) Minogue.
