James C. Towles, Sr, age 85, of Versailles, passed away Monday, February 27, 2017, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. He was born March 12, 1931, in Fairmont, Missouri, a son of the late George David and Florence O. (Nay) Towles.

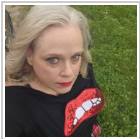
