Janice Ludene Schmidt, Holdeman was born on May 2, 1938 to Cornelius and Alverta Schmidt, in rural McPherson County, Kansas. She unexpectedly, but very peacefully left us at Capital Region Medical Center on October 4, 2021, reaching the age of 83.

As a 5-year-old girl they moved to Harvey County, Kansas, attending at Hesston Congregation. She gave her heart to God, and was baptized on November 11, 1950 by Milford Wenger, and was faithful to her vows until death. Being the 5th child in her family, she enjoyed a happy childhood, often walking two miles to Stone School where she received her formal education.

Her prayer of simple, trusting faith was answered and the well never quit as long as they resided there. She had a steady, even keel, and longed to stick to the old paths. Her life proved out her sincerity, and we have confidence she is resting under the altar.
