



Jerry Lynn Outlaw Sr.

Jerry Lynn Outlaw, Sr., age 72, of Sunrise Beach, passed away Sunday, June 28, 2020, at his home. He was born January 3, 1948, in Abilene, Texas, a son of the late Wilburn B. and Leola Mary (Davault) Outlaw.

On March 25, 1990, in Corona, California, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Kathleen (Vreeland) Outlaw.

Upon graduating high school, Jerry enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. He served in Vietnam and was honorably discharged with the rank of Lance Corporal. Jerry was proud of his grandson, Christian, who followed in his grandfather's footsteps by joining the United States Marine Corps following his high school graduation.

While living in southern California, he owned and operated JMJ Masonry and Concrete Incorporated working as a licensed contractor. Being the selfless man he was, he helped several men throughout the years looking for work to support their families. He taught each one of them a trade they could use for the rest of their lives.

Jerry was a member of the George M. Waddell VFW Post 5178 in Gravois Mills and the American Legion Zack Wheat Post 624 in Sunrise Beach.

Arrangements are under the direction and care of the Kidwell-Garber Laurie/Sunrise Beach Chapel.

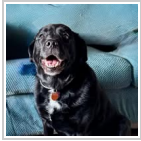
