Jewell O. Haile, age 77, of Versailles, left the bonds of earth on January 10, 2013, to rejoin her beloved husband, Roy E. Haile, in Heaven. They were married on September 14, 1954, and had enjoyed 41 years of marriage at the time of his death on September 12, 1995.

she canned vegetables and made jelly, juice and pickles. Her home and yard were always filled with flowers, many of which she nursed through the winter and set out again in the spring.

She always took great care with her looks, even polishing her nails the day before her heart surgery. Her children thought she was the most beautiful woman they had ever seen. Her beauty and her big heart will be greatly missed by her family and friends.
