



Joseph Ree Carver

August 24, 1947 - June 3, 2021

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the sudden passing of Joseph ("Joe") Ree Carver, age 73, of Arnold, MO, on June 3, 2021. A loving, compassionate, and spiritual man who was loved by so many for the joy and laughter he brought to their lives; and even those he barely knew.

Joe was a 1966 graduate of the Missouri School for the Deaf ("MSD") in Fulton, MO. He excelled on the high school football and basketball teams and made lifelong friends with many of his Deaf classmates. It was also here he met his high-school sweetheart, Janice Dautenhahn. They married on Valentine's Day, 1970 and just celebrated 51 years of marriage this year.

Joe learned the value of hard work early in life. His first job was working for his father during summers home from MSD. His father taught him valuable carpentry skills, building houses and working on other various construction projects. After graduation from high school, he moved to the St. Louis area and found employment as a cabinet-maker and laminator for countertops until his retirement in 2011. His attention to detail was second-to-none, and he always demanded a quality product. On the side, he would often do small wood-working projects as gifts to lucky family members, and gave his time to help in the construction of his sister's, sister's-in-law, and daughter's houses.

After retirement, he spent his extra time with simple, relaxing outdoor

activities. He was a member of the Deaf Bass Anglers Club, competing in several bass fishing tournaments. He and Janice enjoyed socials with several of their friends in the Deaf community and would make occasional trips back to MSD for homecoming football games and alumni reunions. They made frequent outings to several local and state parks, sometimes renting new vehicles for short road trips, as he loved cars and the chance to "try-out" various makes and models. He often attended his two grandson's baseball games, proudly cheering them on as they stepped up to the plate or onto the pitcher's mound, and proudly saw his hearing-impaired granddaughter graduate with her degree in Physical Therapy. On April 8, 2021, he became a proud GREAT grandpa to Easton Joseph Grindell (named after him). He spoke often of his birthplace off 135-3 in Camden County and his other hometown, Gravois Mills. His love for his parents and siblings was so genuine, and they would spend many hours engrossed in conversation, using their special, made-up "home signs". He had a great sense of humor and was extremely animated. The family loved his rendition of "Cowboys and Indians", using a mix of ASL (American Sign Language), dramatic gestures, and expressions. He had an awesome appetite for life, the nearest buffet, and ICE CREAM!

Joe is survived by his wife, Janice Carver; his daughter, Jeanie Carver; two sisters, Joyce Bolton (husband Richard) and Ruth Weaver; three grandchildren, Brendan Grindell, Connor Grindell and Megan Grindell and one great-grandson, Easton Grindell. He was preceded in death by his father, Samuel Carver; his younger brother, Samuel ("Sammy") Lee Carver; then his beloved mother, Bertha Carver.
