Joyce Ann McHenry, age 82, of Laurie, Missouri, passed away Tuesday, January 26, 2021 at Lake Regional Hospital, Osage Beach, Missouri. She was born December 20, 1938 in Tuscarawas, Ohio, a daughter of Walter James and Lelia Anna (Sindlinger) Roth.

On July 22, 1962 in Tuscarawas, Ohio, she was united in marriage to Ralph Duane "Mack" McHenry. Together they shared forty-six years of marriage before his passing on March 23, 2009.

She was also preceded in death by her parents and a brother, James Roth.
