Carla Catherine Fuller, 76, passed away on May 1, 2024 at Lake Regional Hospital.

Carla “Kathy” was born on June 12, 1947 to Vern and Louise Brewer in Kansas City, Missouri. She grew up with her mother and her grandparents, Albert and Vera Lewis, in Holden, Missouri, where her grandfather owned a feed store. Kathy attended Holden High School, where she graduated in 1965.
