



Kay (Hutchison) Williams

Leona “Kay” (Hutchison) Williams, age 78, of Versailles, passed away Tuesday, May 3, 2022, at Boone Hospital Center in Columbia. She was born July 12, 1943, in Latham, a daughter of the late Leo Libbert and Erma Arlene (McBroom) Hutchison.

Kay went to Morgan County R-II school and graduated in 1961.

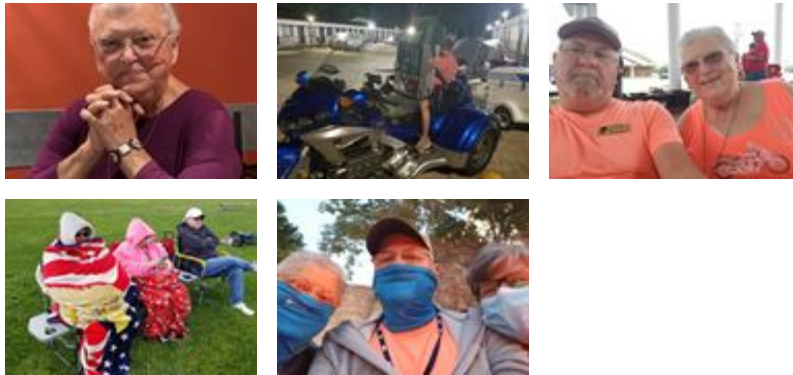

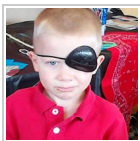
