



## Kenneth Warren Dunstan

March 25, 1929 - September 12, 2015

Kenneth Warren Dunstan, age 86, passed away peacefully at his home, with his wife by his side on Saturday morning, September 12, 2015.

He was born March 25, 1929, to Bernum "BA" and Hazel (Schlup) Dunstan. He was a lifelong resident of Miller County until his move to Versailles. He enjoyed his Monday night card games and playing golf.
