February 24, 1928 - October 23, 2012

Joyce Taylor “Kirk” Kirkpatrick, age 84, of Laurie, passed away Tuesday, October 23, 2012, at the Laurie Care Center. He was born February 24, 1928, in Schell City, Missouri, a son of the late Joyce Taylor, Sr. and Louise Berniece Williams Kirkpatrick.

On March 13, 1946, in Kansas City, Missouri, he was united in marriage to Peggy Louise Montgomery, who preceded him in death on May 22, 1991. He later married Shirley Hunter on October 4, 2003, in Laurie, and she survives the home.

Kirk was a United States Navy veteran serving from 1946 to 1948.

He worked in various sales positions throughout his career.

Kirk was a charter member of the West Lake Christian Church in Laurie. Some of his duties at church included serving as an elder, chairman of the board and chairman of the search committee. He was also a past member of the Osage Community Elks Lodge 2705 in Laurie.
