Larry O. Bradley, age 66, of Versailles, passed away Tuesday, September 25, 2012, at his home. He was born September 23, 1946, in Doris, California, a son of Lloyd O. and Dollie Rayl Bradley.

On November 14, 1980, in Lee's Summit, he was united in marriage to Norma Evans who survives the home.
