



## Larry Raymond Jepsen

May 16, 1940 - July 3, 2022

Larry Raymond Jepsen, age 82, of Laurie, passed away Sunday, July 3, 2022, at St. Louis University Hospital in St. Louis. He was born May 16, 1940, in Battle Creek, Iowa, a son of the late Raymond and Lucille (Baeth) Jepsen.

He was united in marriage to Barbara Miaczynski who preceded him in death on September 16, 1982. On February 16, 1985, he married his surviving wife, Mary Zumbahl.

Larry grew up on a farm in Iowa and occasionally enjoyed going back to Schleswig to help his brother and dad for many years.
