She always attended the performances by her son Jeremy in school and church drama, and later when he started a band with his friends she was proudly known as the “rock mom”.

She was united in marriage to her companion of 24 years, Donald “Sam” R. Winfrey, on October 26, 2005. After his passing in 2006 she pursued a career as a pilot car driver and absolutely loved traveling all across the country. She

retired at the beginning of 2019 and moved in with her daughter Cyndi where she lived until her passing.
