Leroy Henry Nolting, 85, of Stover, passed away Tuesday morning, November 28, 2006 at Golden Age Living Center in Stover. He was born on September 2, 1921 at Glensted, Missouri, the son of Fredrick August Heinrich "Fritz" and Anna Maria Windler Nolting.

On September 19, 1948 he married Ardella Emma Louise Hagedorn in Stover.

Leroy was confirmed on August 30, 1936 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Pymont, Missouri, by the Rev. D.E. Meyer. He was a member of Christ Lutheran Church in Stover. He attended Bethel School north of Versailles. He served in the U.S. Army in World War II with the 534th Battalion, obtained the rank of Technician Fifth Grade, and was stationed in Germany, France and Italy. He was awarded 5 Bronze Stars and the Good Conduct Medal. He was a farmer, gravel hauler and worked for the Morgan County R-II School as a bus driver.

Survivors include his wife of Stover; one granddaughter, Crystal Joy Dority of Roswell, Georgia, and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Cheryl Ann Dority on October 4, 1990; two brothers, Harry Nolting and Herbert Nolting, and one sister Selma Nolting.

Funeral services will be at 11:00 a.m. Friday, December 1, at Christ Lutheran

Church in Stover, with Gary Wahlers officiating. Military honors and interment will be in Kipp Memorial Cemetery in Stover.
