



Lonnie Keith Silkwood

August 8, 1945 - April 22, 2018

Lonnie Keith Silkwood, age 72, of Barnett, passed away Sunday, April 22, 2018, at the Harry S. Truman Memorial Veterans Hospital in Columbia. He was born August 8, 1945, in Kingston, Missouri, a son of the late Ora and Anna (Baker) Silkwood.

On June 5, 1964, in Polo, Missouri, he was united in marriage to his surviving wife, Norma (Christopher) Silkwood.

Lonnie was a veteran of the United States Army, having served during Vietnam.

He was employed by Ameren as a lineman and later as a meter reader, retiring with more than twenty years of service.

Lonnie was very involved in youth sports when his children were young. He coached baseball, girls and boys basketball and assisted the high school girls basketball coaches. He was also instrumental in rebuilding the baseball field in Versailles. In addition to cheering for local teams, Lonnie was an avid St. Louis Cardinals baseball fan.

He was a member of the Versailles Calvary Baptist Church.

In addition to his wife, Norma, he is survived by his children, Kelly Hampshire and husband Brad of Kansas City, Missouri, Jared Silkwood of Versailles, Missouri and Micah Silkwood and wife Shalinn of Kansas City, Missouri; six grandchildren, Gavin Silkwood, Bre Kamaka, Hunter Hampshire, Marisa Hampshire, Logan Silkwood and Daphne Silkwood; brother, Norman Silkwood and wife Sandra of Warrensburg, Missouri and many other relatives and friends.
