February 1, 1928 - January 9, 2016

Lou Marshall, age 87, of Versailles, formerly a longtime resident of Sunrise Beach, passed away Saturday, January 9, 2016, at her home. She was born February 1, 1928, in Randle, Missouri, a daughter of the late Oscar David and Minnie Ellen (Driskell) Kittle.

On November 23, 1947, she was united in marriage to her surviving husband, Donald W. Marshall.

Lou was employed with the J.C. Penney Company, retiring after forty years of service. She was one of the first female store managers for the J.C. Penney Company. At the time of her retirement, she was the manager of the Fulton, Missouri store.

She was a member of the Ozark Paradise Chapter of the American Business Women Association, the American Legion Auxiliary Unit 624 in Sunrise Beach, the Heart of America Chapter HCSC (J.C. Penney Retired Managers Association) and a longtime member of the Heart of America Boat Club, Kansas City, Missouri. For many years, she was a member of the Rolling Hills Country Club in Versailles, where she enjoyed playing golf and card games with her friends.

In addition to her husband Don, of sixty-eight years, she is survived by her

children, Floyd Epperson and wife Terry of Roanoke Rapids, North Carolina, Gary Marshall and wife Cindy of Lee's Summit, Missouri and Donna Abbott and husband Dean of Ocean Shores, Washington; nine grandchildren; twelve great-grandchildren and many other relatives and friends. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by five siblings.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m., Monday, January 18th, at the Kidwell-Garber Funeral Home in Versailles. Graveside services and interment will follow in the Garber Memorial Estates Cemetery in Laurie. The family will receive friends from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m., Monday, at the funeral home.
