Mancil Lee "Mac" Morrison, 93, of Versailles, Missouri, went to be with his Lord and Savior on August 20, 2022 in Hospice at Capital Region Hospital in Jefferson City, Missouri. He was born July 20, 1929 in Linn Creek, Missouri, a son of Melvin Lee and Cora Mae (Ferguson) Morrison.

He married Dorothy Marie Hibdon on March 10, 1951 in Versailles, Missouri. On March 23, 1978, he was united in marriage with Rosemary Carpenter who survives.

Mac was affectionally known as "The Hillbilly", a name he enjoyed being called. He was an active member of the Versailles Assembly of God Church.
