They lived there for 35 years. Ed and Marge then decided it was time to retire and enjoy their beloved lake house full-time. They enjoyed the last 16 years in Sunrise Beach, MO at the Lake of the Ozarks, where they loved their lake home and their time spent there with family. Marge was a huge KC Royals fan, hardly missing a game on TV. She loved to play bingo and visit the casinos.
