Martha Bell Pace, age 89, peacefully passed away at her home in Akinsville, Missouri on February 15, 2021. The youngest of five children, she was born on July 29, 1931, in Fortuna, Missouri to the late George Milburn and Rhettta (Corson) Worley.

siblings: brothers George, Kenneth, and Burl and sister Rose Fowler.
