Martha Sue Smith, age 92, of Laurie, Missouri, passed away Sunday, October 8, 2023 at Cox Medical Center South, Springfield, Missouri. She was born September 2, 1931 in Fayette, Missouri, a daughter of the late Lance and Ethel (Johnson) Overstreet.
