Max Lee Bartley, age 102, of Roach, passed away Monday, June 27, 2022, at his home. He was born February 5, 1920, in Rosedale, Kansas, a son of the late Vern and Marie (Buttman) Bartley.

On August 10, 1946, in Lebanon, he was united in marriage to Icel Maxine Crabtree, who preceded him in death on January 16, 2015.

Max was a United States Army veteran having served in World War II from 1941-1945. He was assigned to assist with the clean up of Pearl Harbor, building an airport in Oahu, constructing the Burma Road in China and performing maintenance on Army vehicles.

Max worked for General Motors and Kansas City Power and Light Company. He moved to the lake and owned Bartley's Plumbing for many years until his retirement.

In his spare time, he enjoyed vegetable gardening, hulling and popping walnuts and going antique shopping with Maxine.

He was a charter member of Lakeland Baptist Church now known as the First Baptist Church in Sunrise Beach. Max was also a charter member of the VFW Post 5923 in Camdenton and the American Legion Zack Wheat Post 624 in

Sunrise Beach.

He is survived by his children, Mary Jo Paulsen and husband Bill of Roach, Missouri, Gary Bartley and friend, Linda Smith of Gravois Mills, Missouri and Terry Schertz and husband Edwin of Sunrise Beach, Missouri; eleven grandchildren; twenty-one great-grandchildren; seven great-great-grandchildren and many other relatives and friends. In addition to his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by his siblings, Kenneth Bartley, Helen Hulseley and Dorothy Hilyard.

Funeral services with full military honors will be held at 12:00 Noon, Thursday, June 30th, at the Kidwell-Garber Laurie/Sunrise Beach Chapel.
