September 18, 1924 - January 14, 2014

Garnett Maxine (Keyes) Bybee, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, passed from her earthly home to her Heavenly home on Tuesday, January 14, 2014, at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. She was born September 18, 1924, in Etterville, Missouri, a daughter of the late Almon James and Margie Ellen (Woods) Keyes.

Maxine was united in marriage on September 8, 1946, to William Glenn Bybee, who preceded her in death on February 17, 2002.

She attended McKinley Grade School and Barnett Schools. Maxine worked as a welder for Common Wealth Aircraft during World War II. She also worked at Kansas City Bifocal in Versailles for many years before becoming a beautician. She was a beautician for over 40 years, closing "Maxine's Beauty Salon" when she was 84 years old.

Maxine was a hard working, kind hearted, compassionate and giving woman. She had a genuine desire to see each person have a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. She loved her job as a beautician and working in the church helping in any way she could. She taught young people for over 30 years at the Versailles First Assembly of God Church.
