Johanna Juliet McDonald, age 95, of Versailles, passed away Thursday evening, July 10, 2003 at her home. She was born September 22, 1907 near Gravois Mills, Missouri, the daughter of Patrick Henry and Harriett (Hattie) Moss McDonald.

Miss McDonald was a school teacher for 44 ½ years and taught biology and physical science in Versailles for 31 ½ years prior to her retirement in 1971. She was an active member of the Morgan County Historical Society for many years, belonged to the Evening Sorosis, Missouri Retired Teacher's Association and the Daughter's of the American Revolution.

She is survived by one niece, Ann Shaw of Versailles; two nephews, Harry McDonald of Kansas City, and Jim McDonald of Blue Springs, several great nieces and great nephews, and many friends. In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by five brothers, John, Harry, Melvin, Richard and Moss McDonald, and one sister, Helen R. McDonald.

Funeral services were held at 11:00 a.m. Monday, July 14, at the Kidwell-Garber Funeral Home in Versailles, with Father James O'Sullivan officiating. Burial was in the St. Patrick Cemetery in Laurie.
