Michael "Mike" William Brown, age 70, of Sunrise Beach, Missouri, departed this life on Wednesday night, May 6, 2015 at his home in Sunrise Beach.

Mike was born on June 22, 1944 in St. Joseph, Missouri, the son of Paul Brown and Lorine (McBeth) Brown.
