Mildred Dump, age 96, of Versailles, passed away Thursday, April 13, 2017, at Capital Region Medical Center in Jefferson City. She was born October 15, 1920, the daughter of the late Forest and Ethel Moon.

She graduated from Versailles High School and was active in Versailles for several years and later attended Sedalia Business College.

In December of 1981, she resigned her job with Denver Social Services due of her health. She and James moved back to Versailles where she became active in the music department at the First Baptist Church where she played the piano and organ for many years. Later, she and James traveled to various

places in the United States during the summers and spent the winters in an RV park in Texas. They were both active in many organizations at the RV park.

She is survived by her husband of sixty-nine years, James; her good friend, Betty Shore; niece, Carol Perkins; nephew, Harold Dump and many friends.
