



Mildred Marie Volkart

October 30, 1920 - April 12, 2015

Mildred Marie Volkart, age 94, of Barnett, went to be with her Lord on Sunday, April 12, 2015 at St. Joseph's Bluffs Care Center in Jefferson City.

Mildred was the daughter of Thomas and Ethel (Waller) Bonine, born October 30, 1920, in Morgan County near Excelsior, Missouri.

Mildred attended grade school near Excelsior and graduated from Versailles High School in 1939. At age 18 she became a member of the Hopewell Christian Church and was baptized in the creek north of the church.

Following graduation, Mildred worked for two years at the California Manufacturing Company in California, Missouri. She met her husband, Kenneth, while working in California. Mildred and Kenneth were married on October 15, 1941 in San Diego, California by the Navy Chaplain. During the war, Mildred returned to Missouri for a short time and worked at Tweedy's Manufacturing plant, making war materials in Versailles.

Mildred accompanied her husband to many duty stations throughout his twenty years of service in the U.S. Navy. After retirement they returned to their farm in Missouri for the remainder of their lives.

Mildred was a member of the Hopewell Union Church. She taught both

children's and adult Sunday school classes.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Thomas and Ethel; her husband, Kenneth; and by two brothers, Melvin and Mancil Bonine.

Mildred is survived by her three children, Beverly Pethan of Jefferson City, Tom Volkart (Elda) of Lohman, and Bob Volkart (Ginny) of Jefferson City; five grandchildren, Lisa Hahm (George), Mark Pethan, Michael Pethan, Carla Volkart and Nick Volkart; along with one great grandchild, Hunter Hahm.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m., on Thursday, April 16, 2015 at the Hopewell Church, near Barnett.

Visitation will be held from 10:00-11:00 a.m., on Thursday, prior to service time.

Burial will follow in the Hopewell Cemetery.
