William David Miller, 90, of Gravois Mills, died Friday, Feb. 14, 2003, at the Lake Regional Health System facility in Osage Beach.

He was born July 30, 1912, in Winslow, Ark., a son of Oda S. and Hattie Pearl Guinn Miller. On May 29, 1940, in Kansas City, he was married to Mattie Lee Williams, who survives of the home.

Mr. Miller worked at General Motors Leeds Plant in Kansas City for several years and later was co-owner of Miller Brothers Sinclair Service Station in Northeast Kansas City. He owned and operated Miller's Shady Rest Resort near Laurie for about 12 years until his retirement. He was an Army Air Corps veteran of World War II and a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post No. 5178 in Gravois Mills. He was a member of the Methodist Church and a 50-year member of the Northeast Sheffield Masonic Lodge in Kansas City. He was an avid fisherman, carpenter and mechanic, and loved the Lake of the Ozarks.

Survivors also include a brother, Charles "Chuck" Miller of Versailles; five sisters, Kathleen Williams and Lilah Riddle, both of Lancaster, Calif., Pearl Patten of St. Croix, Wis., and Gloria Coats and Nita McMann, both of Albuquerque, N.M.; and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Howard Miller, and three sisters, Ona Bess

Lee, Marilyn Sandbrook and Sylvia Powell.

Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Tuesday at Kidwell-Garber Funeral Home in Versailles, with the Rev. Jim Lawley officiating. Burial with military honors will be in the West Lawn Addition of the Versailles Cemetery.
