Lutetia S. Morris, age 106 of Versailles passed away Thursday morning, January 16, 2003 at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. She was born in Cooper County, Missouri on August 18, 1896, a daughter of the late Will and Lutetia Mills Byler.

On July 6, 1918 she was united in marriage with Samuel E. Morris who preceded her in death on October 14, 1968.

She is survived by two sons, William E. Morris of Wilmington, Delaware and Harry Leland Morris of St. Louis, Missouri. Her daughter, Lucille (Grills) preceded Mrs. Morris in death in 1979. Mrs. Morris also is survived by three grandchildren including, James Morris of Leawood, Kansas and Nancy Fitzpatrick of Kansas City; nine great-grandchildren, and by a sister Frances Carpenter of Bella Vista, Arkansas formerly of Kansas City, Kansas.

Mrs. Morris spent her early years in Prairie Home, Missouri and she graduated from California, Missouri High School. She was active for many years in the First Baptist Church, the Eastern Star, the American Legion Auxiliary, and she was a founding member of Calvary Baptist Church.
