Naomi Louise Woods, age 98, of Fortuna, Missouri, passed away Saturday, February 10, 2018 in Tipton Oak Manor, Tipton, Missouri. She was born February 27, 1919 in Moniteau County, Missouri, northeast of Fortuna. She was the only child of Luther Gregory and Rose Nadine (Charles) Woods.

She was a life-long Fortuna resident and was the valedictorian of Fortuna High School class of 1935. She graduated from Central Business College in Sedalia. In 1937, Naomi began a career at Tipton Pants Factory and retired in 1982 after forty-five years of service.

Naomi helped compile the history of local families, including Woods, Henry, Charles, Newkirk, Wright and Hutchison families. For many years, she wrote the Fortuna Items in the Tipton Times and the California Democrat.

She was a lifetime member of the Fortuna United Methodist Church. She also held memberships with the Fortuna Senior Citizens, D.A.R. and Moniteau Historical Society.

She is survived by many cousins and friends. She was preceded in death by her parents, Gregory and Rose.

Services will be held at 2:00 p.m., Friday, February 16, 2018 at Fortuna United Methodist Church. Burial will follow in Tipton Masonic Cemetery. Visitation will be from 1:00-2:00 p.m., Friday in the church.
