Nathan E. Johnson, age 96, of Windsor, Missouri, passed away Saturday, February 19, 2011, at the Golden Valley Hospital in Clinton, Missouri. He was born April 26, 1914, in Linden, Missouri, the son of the late Robert E. Lee and Nora Augusta Voglemann Johnson.
