Orville Virgil Sauerwein, age 77, of Stover, passed away Saturday morning, August 20, 2005 at the Golden Age Living Center in Stover. He was born December 10, 1927 at New Athens, Illinois, the son of Joseph Christian and Alma Anna Winkler Sauerwein.
