Paddy E. Kidwell, age 81, of Versailles, passed away Saturday, May 2, 2015, at the Good Shepherd Care Center in Versailles. She was born February 19, 1934, one mile south of High Point, Missouri, a daughter of the late Bruce Hampton Morris and Camille Blacksten Morris.
