Patricia Rosemary Robinson, age 88, passed away on January 20, 2020, at her home on Highway W, south of Versailles. She was born February 23, 1931, in Gravois Mills, the daughter of the late Ferdinand and Cleo (Silvey) Geiger. She was proud of the fact that she hailed from south Morgan County. She attended schools in south Morgan County and graduated from Versailles High School in 1947.

On May 6, 1949, in Little Rock, Arkansas, she was united in marriage to Robert G. "Bob" Robinson of Versailles. After marrying Bob, she became a military wife and lived at six different military bases until his retirement brought them back to Versailles in 1970. 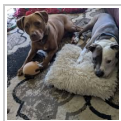
