



## Pattie Jo (Cahill) Calton

June 20, 1945 - January 21, 2024

Pattie Jo (Cahill) Calton of Barnett died on January 21, 2024, at the age of 78, but her caring and always willing-to-help disposition will never be forgotten. She passed at her oldest daughter's home in Sapulpa, Oklahoma, following a long life of adventures and a heroic battle with cancer.

In her life, she valued history, photography, genealogy, crocheting, family, friends, and being a child of Christ. She worked for Fasco Motors for 25 years as a working leader. In her retirement, she volunteered for the Morgan County Historical Museum. Her incredible contributions lead the museum to name the genealogy room after her. She helped many individuals from near and far find family members to fill their family trees.

She is survived by two daughters, Chris Jones and partner Ted Deckard of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, and Elizabeth Stevenson and husband Craig of Monon, Indiana; four grandchildren, Olivia Banks and husband Colton of Bixby, Oklahoma, Daniel Jones of Sapulpa, Oklahoma, Paisley Stevenson and Archer Stevenson of Monon, Indiana; three great-granddaughters, Brailey Banks and Oakleigh Banks of Bixby, Oklahoma, and Jerra Jones of Sapulpa, Oklahoma; many nieces and nephews; and other family and friends.
